## FROM OUR RABBI



"Let us understand our days are numbered, let us become wise-hearted"

We do not know how much time we have. Some of us will not be here next year because death is sometimes cruel and unpredictable. These past few years have been brutal and heartbreaking for many of us, having to confront death not as a fear, but as reality. Others of us are actively fighting to stay what cannot be avoided only delayed. So a holiday that tells us to confront death is hardly an easy thing to embrace, unless we understand the message of this day to be life-affirming. Which it is. This day is about how we live. We are best served when we are motivated by desire for the good rather than fear of the bad, by love of self and not shame or grief over our mistakes. Today is about letting go of that.

It's an obligation to enjoy our lives. It's okay to be happy. I'm telling myself this as much as you, and I encourage you to remind yourselves as well, as often as you need to. If you aren't encouraging yourself, it's hard to hear others encouraging you. Live. Grieve when you must, make space for it, don't ignore it, but continue to pursue all that is your potential. You must want to live fully and to your best, otherwise all of this doesn't matter.

How we spend the time we have is of the utmost importance. And the only time we know we have is right now. Not hours from now. Not days, not years. Accepting this is not an excuse for cynicism or unchecked hedonism or irresponsibility, although I understand those responses because they are human responses to fear and grief and trauma and life is filled with lots of those things. But life is also filled with joy and beauty and wonder and we Jews are charged with increasing these things in the world through study and practice of Torah.

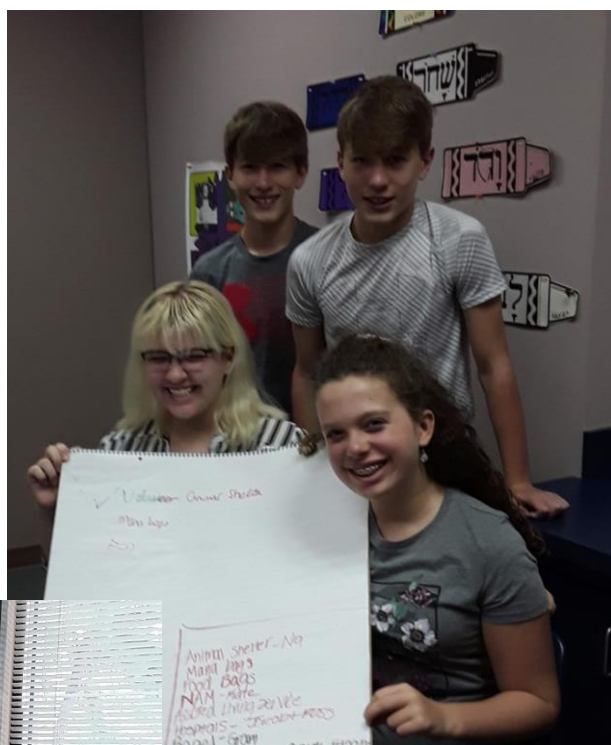
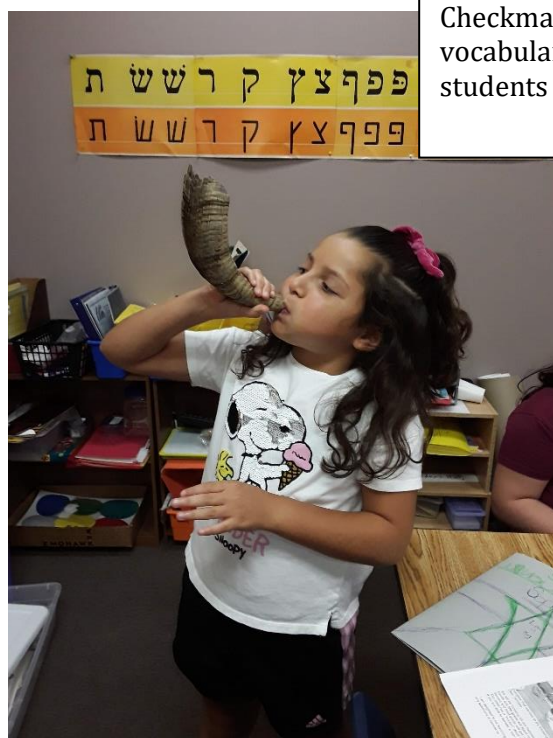


## Religious School Updates from Kylie Danielson, Director

Camp Aviv has kicked off another exciting school year. We welcomed two new teachers, Morah Deitsch and Morah Heathman, as well as a few new families.

Our curricular focus this year is the song "Echad Mi Yodea" which teaches 13 of the most important concepts in Judaism. So far our students have had thoughtful discussions on the meaning of one G-d, made and shattered their own 10 commandments, and learned stories about the *avot* and *imahot* from Genesis.

Our older students are taking on service-learning projects through studying the text *Elu d'varim* and developing community service projects. Our Hebrew Through Movement specialist, Morah Checkman, engages our students in actively building their Hebrew vocabularies. Our staff continues to do amazing things with their students each week!

In doing so, he discovers that, despite allegations of war crimes, the former commander has become a man of importance in industry in post-war Germany, protected from prosecution by a powerful organization of former SS members called Odessa."

## Ways to Honor Friends and Family and Benefit CJCJN

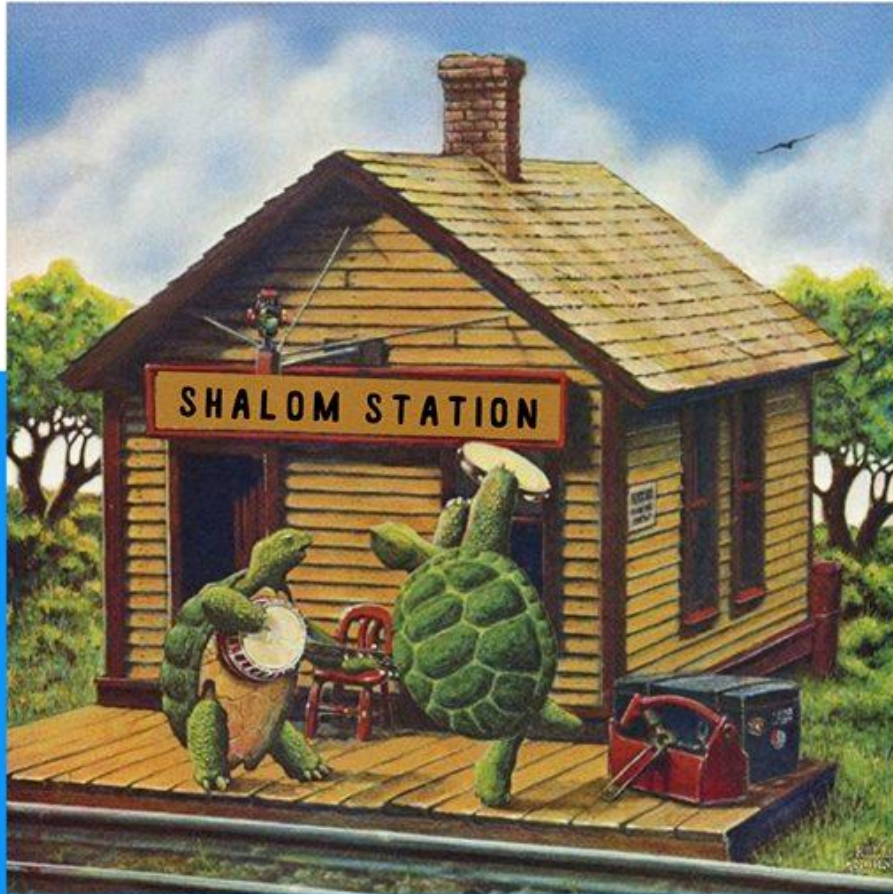
