FROM OUR RABBI



Shalom, everyone!

When I was a boy, I used to love the Temple newsletter. It was printed on goldenrod-colored paper and it was set in an elegant, evocative, and vaguely exotic typeface. It was the first place I was ever published; a poem honoring Golda Meir I had written was selected for inclusion. It smelled like old-fashioned newspapers.

That newsletter reminded me of a place where I felt at home — where I was not the only Jewish kid in the building. Where my curiosity, my engagements with teachers, and my desire to learn were celebrated, and where I was not bullied. A place where I was safe.

In an age long before the internet, where social media would be unimaginable, the newsletter was the primary point of contact we had with our congregation when we were not physically at the congregation. It was a critical, if not central expression of a community.

Times have changed, and today a newsletter is a nice supplement, but it does not come close to the power or immediacy of e-mail, texts, Facebook posts, websites, and related forms of contact. As much as I rely on contemporary technology, a large part of me longs for that simpler, slower time.

All our lives have drastically changed with the emergence of this pandemic and at least for now, there is greater need to connect people to community when they are not physically able to be in the building. Telecommunication is literally the only way we have to gather together right now. Never more than now do I appreciate the physical experience of holding a newsletter, rather than swiping through virtual pages on a screen. To have physical contact with part of my congregation. I know I'm not alone in that sentiment, and it's important to me that you know that you are not alone either.

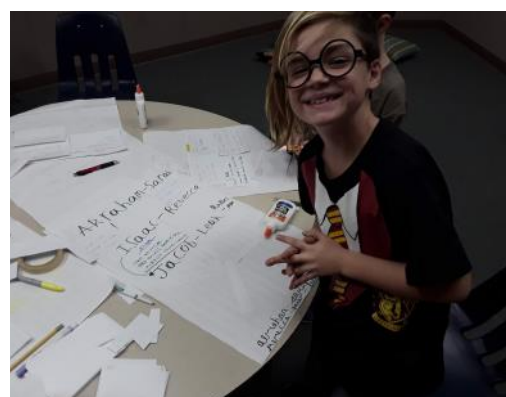
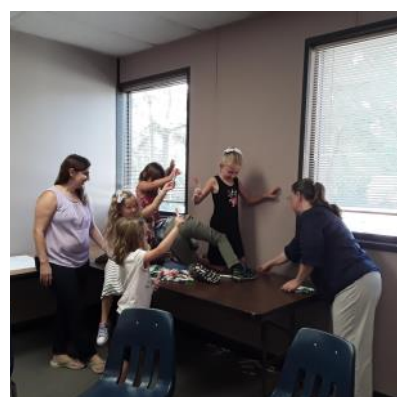
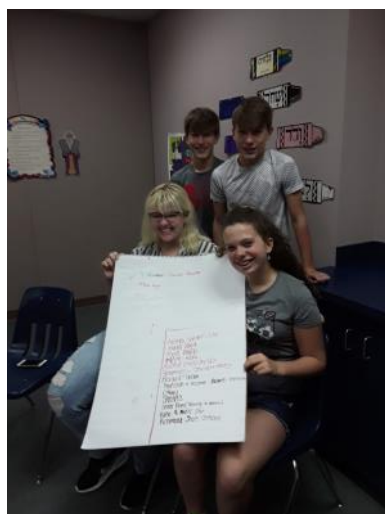
Religious School Updates from Kylie Danielson, Director

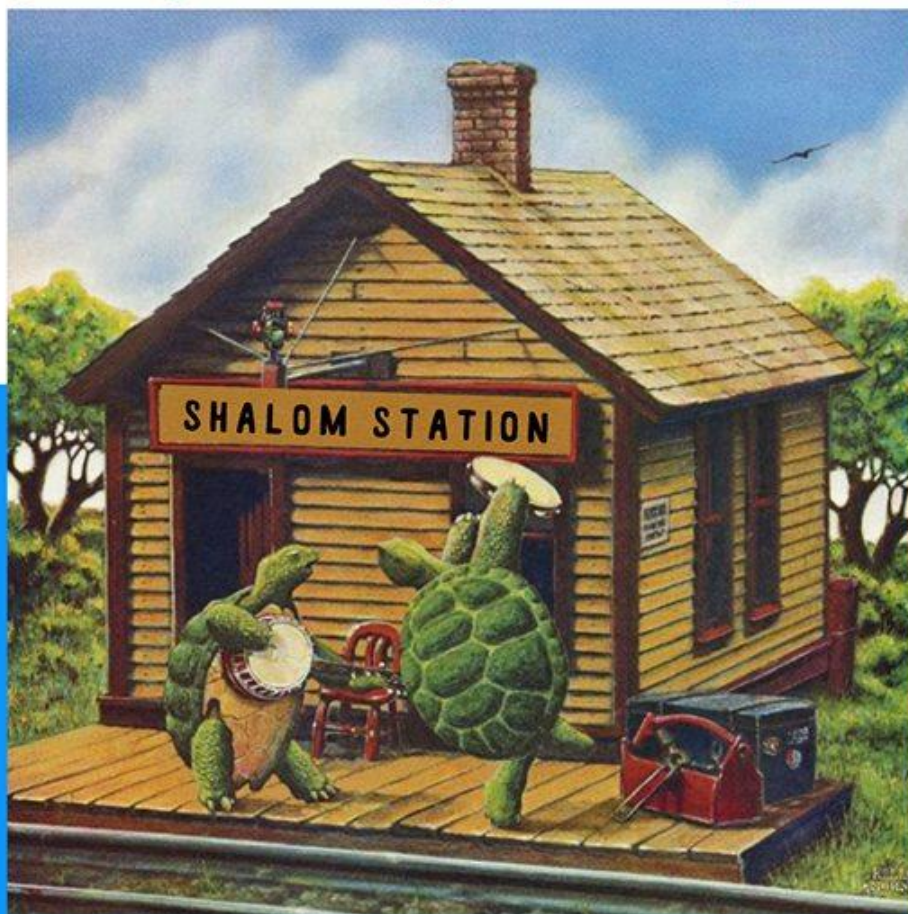

whenever there is a special CJCN event.

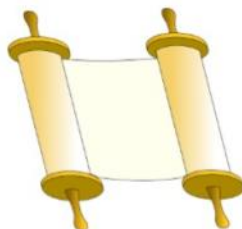
